Instructions for Connecting

Current SSID: { please see the front desk }

Current WEP key: { please see the front desk }

To connect using Windows XP:

- Click the Start button
- Click My Network Connections

- Click View Network Connections under the Tasks section
- Right-click the "Wireless Network Connection" icon and choose Properties
- Choose "Wireless Networks" tab from the pop-up dialog box
- Click "Add" button
- Enter the following parameters:
 - SSID: (see above)
 - Network Authentication: Shared
 - Data Encryption: WEP
 - Uncheck "the key is provided for me automatically"
 - Enter the WEP Encryption Key in both the "Network Key" and "Confirm Network Key" box (see above).
 - Click OK.

- The computer should now begin to detect the wireless network automatically.
- The WEP encryption key is changed periodically for security practices, so if you are not able to connect it may be that you need the new WEP Key.
- If you are still not able to connect, please do not ask us to help you, as we cannot take responsibility for your computer. Thank you.
